Instructions and Application for students who are applying for the Federal Teach Grant

1. Students must determine if students meet the eligibility requirements to receive a Teach Grant. Students must have a 3.25 GPA (high school or college); is a U.S. citizen; a high school graduate pursuing 1st bachelor degree or pursuing a master degree and pursuing one of the following Teach Grant eligible majors that are listed below.

- Mathematics
- English language acquisition
- Foreign language
- Special education
- Science
- Bilingual education
- Reading specialist

- Or if any other field that has been identified as high-need by the federal government, a state government agency, or a local education agency, and is included in the Department's annual Teacher Shortage Area Nationwide listing. 2. Students if meeting the eligibility requirements must submit a copy of this form to the Office of Financial Aid. Be sure to login at <https://teach-ats.ed.gov> the Teach Grant website to complete the Initial Counseling session. Also, accept the award on WEBSIS and complete the Agreement to Serve (ATS) form on the Teach Grant website.
 3. Make sure all items on this form are entered and legible and submit the original to the Associate Director or designated person in the Office of Financial Aid.

Students are to understand that if they are unable to meet the conditions of the Agreement to Serve the Teach Grant will become a Federal Direct Unsubsidized Student Loan with interest accrued and capitalized from the original grant disbursement.
