Morgan State University (MSU) is a historically black university, according to the Higher Education Act of 1965, and a minority-serving institution, as defined by 20 U.S.C. 1067k.

MSU meets the definition set forth by 20 U.S.C 1067k, with 80.0% of its students being of underrepresented minority backgrounds. The detailed numbers, from Fall 2023, are shown below:
