


HBCU Engage 2024

NSF GRANTED Symposium April 26th, 2024 10am-3pm UMBC Campus

UMBC, Morgan State University, and Delaware State University are collaborating on Growing Research Access for Nationally Transformative Equity and Diversity (GRANTED) funded by the NSF.

Over 100 applicants were interested in the pilot internship program with 6 finalists (two per university) selected. These student interns are gaining insights into the possibilities of a career in research administration and some attended the NCURA Region II meeting held in November 2023.

The three universities will co-host a symposium designed to foster further development of a regional student research administration internship pipeline program.
